



St. Teresa of Avila (1515-1582) 15th October

As a woman, Teresa stood on her own two feet, even in the man's world of her time. She was "her own woman," entering the Carmelites despite strong opposition from her father. She is a person wrapped not so much in silence as in mystery. Beautiful, talented, outgoing, adaptable, affectionate, courageous, enthusiastic, she was totally human. She founded over a half-dozen new monasteries. She travelled, wrote, fought—always to renew, to reform. In her self, in her prayer, in her life, in her efforts to reform, in all the people she touched, she was a woman for others, a woman who inspired and gave life. Her writings, especially *The Way of Perfection* and *The Interior Castle*, have helped generations of believers.



CPP Encounter for Parents Course Over the last few years, we have seen the need to help parents be more prepared for teaching and sharing the faith with their children. The request has come from Pope Francis, the diocese, and some parents. We have designed a very informative three session course for parents to take place in October and November. The first session will be this Friday 15th from 7:30 pm – 8:45 pm October in the church. (Registration from 7pm) The course is open to all parents of young children, but it will be a *requirement* for parents who hope to enrol their child on the next First Holy Communion Programme. At the end of the course (assuming attendance at all three sessions) parents will be awarded the CPP Encounter Certificate which will allow them to enrol their children on the First Holy Communion Programme. Unless at least one parent has the certificate, the parents will have to wait until completing the next "Encounter" course in autumn 2022 before that they can enrol the child for First Holy. Come, Follow Me

Perhaps we know the story of the rich, young man well, but listen to it with new ears this weekend.

The young man, living well by the commandments, encounters Christ and is challenged to "Go, sell what you have, and give to the poor... then come, follow me."

"Indeed," St. Paul tells us, "the word of God is living and effective, sharper than any two-edged sword" (Heb. 4:12-13). The words of Jesus cut to the heart of this young man, who wants to follow a series of rules and check the boxes instead of participating in a life-giving relationship with Christ.
