





Sunday, May 11, 2025 | Fourth Sunday of Easter | John 10:27-30

Friends, our Gospel reading today is extremely short, but it is packed with theological and spiritual significance. We hear first of a voice: "My sheep hear my voice." How wonderful and strange that Christianity is not a set of ideas. It's not a philosophy or an ideology. It's a relationship with someone who has a voice. The first disciples were privileged to hear the voice of the historical Jesus, its very particular tonality and texture.

But we hear his voice too, in our own way, when we hear the Scriptures proclaimed at Mass. Mind you, we don't just read the Bible; we hear the Bible. We hear the voice of Jesus too when the bishops and the popes speak. We can also hear the voice of Jesus in our conscience, which Newman called "the aboriginal vicar of Christ in the soul."

We can hear the voice of Jesus in good spiritual friends as well, in those people who comfort us and challenge us and keep calling us to higher ideals and encouraging us when we fall. We listen to Jesus because he is leading us to a renewed and transformed life on high with God.


May 13 is the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima

Weybridge Parish Representatives Meeting Summary

The Weybridge Representatives Parish Meeting on April 5, 2025, was an important step on uniting individual parishes into one collective parish as part of Bishop Richard's Pastoral Plan. This restructuring aims to enhance pastoral care, support clergy, and strengthen community engagement while ensuring the sustainability of parish operations. The transition aligns with the vision of parishes being "communities of saints and welcoming schools of discipleship."

The Meeting Objectives were:

- To share progress on building the Pastoral Plan and restructuring efforts;
- To foster unity among parish members by strengthening relationships;
- To discuss priorities in formation, mission, and prayer to guide the new structure;
- To address concerns about the evolving role of priests and parish leadership;
- To provide solutions for better coordination, communication, and efficiency.

The meeting centred around the SWOT Analysis of all parishes:

Strengths: the parishes offer high-quality liturgical services, strong engagement through newsletters, volunteers, large numbers of youth taking part in sacramental programs and charity work.

Weaknesses: challenges include a consumerist attitude towards faith, leading to declining sacramental participation after Confirmation.

Opportunities: The parishes can improve evangelization efforts, better share resources among Catholic communities, and enhance communication between churches.

Threats: There is concern over inefficient communication between churches, overburdening certain parishes, committee complexity slowing progress. A risk of volunteer burnout also needs to be addressed. This provided valuable insights into shaping a more unified, efficient, and mission-driven parish, ensuring it thrives for future generations. It also identified immediate opportunities in the areas of communication between parishes, exchanging up-to-date information about Mass times, share and re-apply practices, which already started happening between some of the parishes. Also, it was mentioned that it is important to envision, excite and engage communities with the opportunities presented by these changes.
