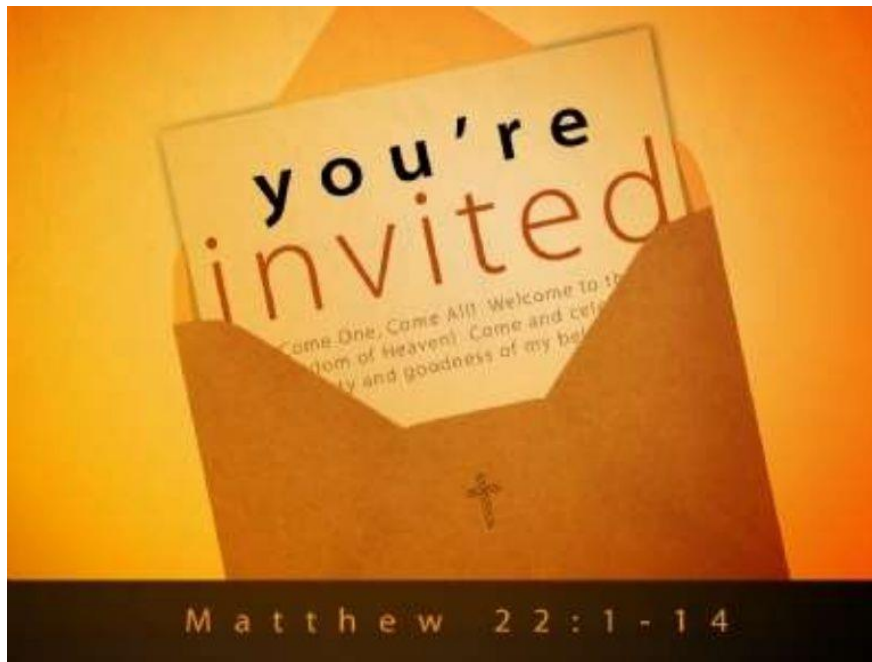

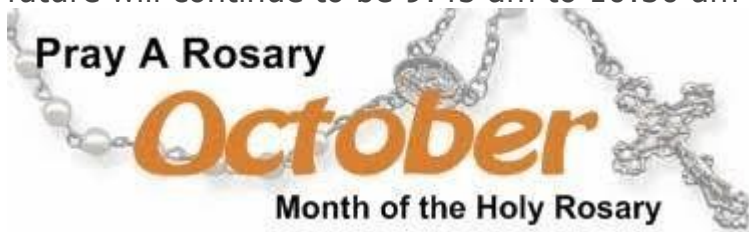

## **Lecture Series**

### ***The False Divide: Science v Religion***

A fact-based exploration to dispel the myths of incompatibility. The first lecture will take place in the church, but due to restrictions on numbers only parents of children on the First Holy Communion program can attend in person. The talk will be live streamed so people can tune in from home. Parents of First Holy Communion children must attend this session in person as this is part of the Parents Encounter Course and there will be some extra input for parents (which will not be live streamed).
