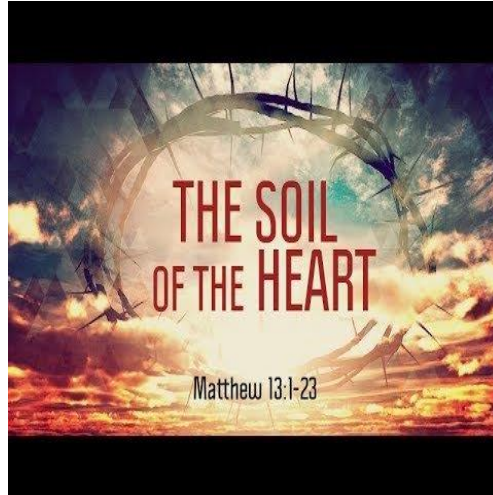

## **Mass Schedule and New Arrangements to ensure safe celebration of Mass**

The government and bishops conference have granted permission for public Masses to be celebrated from Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> of July, subject to various social distancing rules and procedures.

There is no obligation for everyone to return to Mass at the church in the short term. Indeed, we would recommend that anyone in the "at risk" category, or anyone with worries about being close to others, should not return yet and instead join us through the live stream facility on the parish website. The church will be open every day (times below) so there will be opportunities to participate in weekday Masses or to visit the church at quiet times.

We will continue to live stream one Mass every day, as well as the Rosary (Monday to Saturday) and Eucharistic Adoration (Monday to Friday).

We intend to observe the 2m social distancing guideline in the church building so our capacity will be significantly reduced. For some of our busier Masses we will also use the parish hall where Mass will be live streamed, or parishioners may decide to stay outside the church and participate in the Mass through their mobile phone or iPad (you will need to use your own data!). Holy Communion will be brought to those outside the church.

The new procedures include the following –

- Stewards will be on hand to assist with seating and giving direction for receiving Holy communion. Please follow their guidance.
- Hand sanitizers available at the entrance.
- Priest and Eucharistic Ministers to use hand sanitizers before and after the distribution of Holy Communion.
- Communion will be under one kind (no receiving from the chalice).
- The Eucharist is to be received only in the hand.
- As we are observing the 2m rule (face masks will be optional).
- The toilets will not be available (on the instruction of the diocese).
- Please do not touch any of the statues in the church.
- No singing in church is permitted (we will play recorded hymns and live instrumental music).
- Sacrament of Reconciliation by appointment (for the next few weeks)

From **this Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> July** our Sunday Masses will be at **9:00 am, 10:30 am** and **6:00 pm**. There will be no Saturday evening Mass during July and August.

The only Sunday Mass that will be live streamed will be at 10:30 am.

We will also live stream the 12:00 noon Mass (Monday – Saturday).
