Confirmation

If you are in year 10 or above and would like to receive the sacrament of Confirmation in 2021 please attend our information evening (with one parent) on **Tuesday 6th October at 7.30pm**. Application forms are available on the parish website.

First Holy Communion 2021

If you have a child in year 3 or above and would like the child to receive their First Holy Communion in 2021 please attend our parents information evening on **Tuesday 29th September at 7.30pm (please note the date change)**. Application forms are available on the parish website. Please note that one parent will need to complete the CPP Encounter for Parents Course (see below) before the child will be accepted onto the program.

CPP Encounter for Parents Course

Over the last few years we have seen the need to help parents be more prepared for teaching and sharing the faith with their children. The request has come from Pope Francis, the diocese, and some parents. We have designed a very informative three session course for parents to take place at the end of October/start of November. The course is open to all parents of young children, but it will be a **requirement** for parents who hope to enrol their child on the next First Holy Communion Programme. At the end of the course (assuming attendance at all three sessions) parents will be awarded the CPP Encounter Certificate which will allow them to enrol their children on the First Holy Communion Programme. Unless at least one parent has the certificate, the parents will have to wait until completing the next "Encounter" course in autumn 2021 before that they can enrol the child for First Holy Communion. The same parent should attend all three Encounter sessions. The dates for the three sessions are:

Tuesday 20th October, Wednesday 4th November and Tuesday 10th November.
