





Friends, in today's Gospel, Jesus prays for our unity with him and for us to be immersed in God's love: "I made known to them your name and I will make it known, that the love with which you loved me may be in them and I in them."

We are not simply supplicants or penitents, calling to God from without; we are sons and daughters, friends, calling to him from within. The Paschal Mystery is intelligible only in the light of the doctrine of the Trinity. God so loved the world that he sent his only Son, even to the limits of godforsakenness, even into sin and death, into the darkest corners of human experience, in order to find us.

But this acrobatic act of love is possible only if there is in the very being of God a sender and one that he can send, only if there is a Father and a Son. The language Jesus uses—"that they may be brought to perfection as one, that the world may know that you sent me, and that you loved them even as you loved me"—shows us that the Father and the Son are united in love, and this love is itself the divine life.

Thus there is a Spirit, coequal to the Father and the Son.





### ***The Birthday of the Church***

The feast of Pentecost is often referred to as the birthday of the Church?

It is called that because Pentecost is when the apostles went out among the people and began spreading Jesus' message,

thus establishing the beginning of the Church. On this day we are asked to pray for the Church and her continued growth. Pentecost, Greek for 50th day,

is celebrated by Christians fifty days after Easter. In Britain, Pentecost is also called Whitsun, because on this day new Christians used to be baptised. Often they wore white, so Pentecost was known as White Sunday. White Sunday was then shortened to Whitsun. To celebrate Pentecost, read the Acts of the Apostles. Find out what happened to the Church following the events of Pentecost.



St. Charles Lwanga, born in 1860 in the southern region of modern-day Uganda, served in the court of King Mwanga II. The King had begun executing Christian missionaries and any of his citizens who converted. Among those executed were Charles Lwanga and many of his companions. Burnt alive, he died on June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 1886, and was declared a saint by Pope Paul VI in 1964.

"The blood of the martyrs is the seed of the Church," wrote Tertullian, a 2<sup>nd</sup> Century writer and disciple. The heroic men and women, up and down the ages, inspire us to be bold witnesses of Jesus Christ in our world today!
