Mass Arrangements - We are advising most parishioners to participate in the Mass via the live stream. The church remains open every day for Mass and private prayer. As a parish community we have decided to make some changes so that the church an even safer place. There is now more space between the pews. Family liturgy will not take place until things have improved and there are changes to Mass times and the hours for Eucharistic adoration (see schedule). Just to remind you that there is no obligation to attend Mass currently. Our quietest weekend Masses are the 6pm Saturday evening Mass, and 9am on Sunday. Numbers are limited in the church. If the new lower capacity is reached late arrivals will be directed to the hall. Some people may wish to avail of the opportunity to visit the church when it is quiet and spend time in adoration. We remain open every day. Please wear a face covering while inside the church.

Lent

At the beginning of Lent the Church always takes us into the wilderness with Jesus, to face the power that is opposed to the Gospel. The Good News is that we do this *with Jesus and in the company of His followers*. None of us should have to face the wilderness alone; none of us should be thrown back on our own resources. We are all tempted; we all fail; we all sin. Sometimes we might wonder if there is an exit from the wilderness. We all need to hear (like Jesus did) the voice of the Father. That voice reminds us to stay in the company of the one who loves us....Lent reminds us of our need to begin again facing the enemy within us. The Good News is that when we do that we take the road that leads to the kingdom of God.
