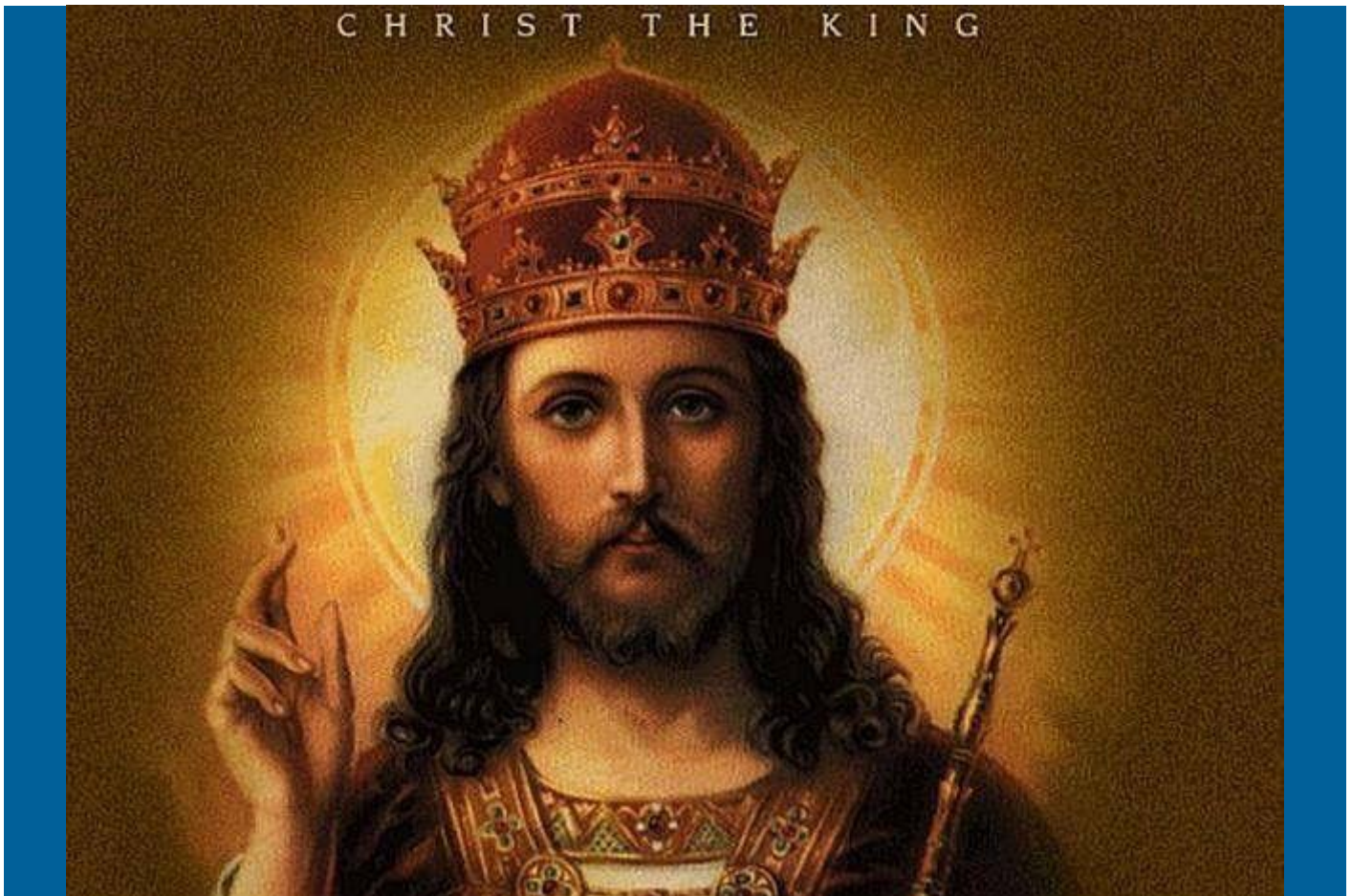

Family Liturgy

At the 10.30am Mass Families with young children (those who have not yet started preparation for First Holy Communion) will be invited to attend Mass in the parish hall, where the family can occupy a table (if families prefer to be in the church that's great too!). The livestreamed Mass will be projected on a large screen. We will switch off the sound for the readings and use a microphone to read a children's version of the gospel. After introducing any creative activities, the leader switches the sound back on so that parents can follow the Mass while their children do the activity. Communion will be brought to the hall so that parents and older children can receive.

A two-year 'synodal' process is taking place across the Catholic Church

This is an important moment in the life of the world Church, with Pope Francis calling us all to reflect on the theme *For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation and Mission*. The Pope is inviting us to take this journey together. As the Preparatory Document for the Synod expresses, “This path of walking together is the most effective way of manifesting and putting into practice the nature of the Church as the pilgrim and missionary People of God.” The Synodal process will take place in three stages. It will begin in our Diocese next month (December 2021), with Synod questions sent to parishes, uploaded to our website, and shared across our channels.

Feast of Saint Cecilia

November 22nd

The power of music in Christian worship is obvious. Music can have many qualities - spiritual, emotional, theological, intellectual. We may respond in a variety of ways. Militant songs stir our spirits; quiet songs make us reflective; joyful songs cheer us up and so on. But most importantly our hymns are not intended as entertainment, but as an integral part of the liturgy. When churchgoers sit back and observe performances, then they are reduced to being consumers instead of participants. On this the feast of St Cecilia, patron saint of music, we are asked to emulate her example. Like any good Christian, Cecilia sang in her heart, and sometimes with her voice. She has become a symbol of the Church's conviction that good music is an integral part of the liturgy.

All Hail Christ the King!

After honoring our dead and hearing this month of the apocalypse ("unveiling") and end times, this November Sunday closes the Church's liturgical year with the great feast of "Christ the King." Pontius Pilate, and all the political rulers throughout history, have limited power. But we profess faith and loyalty to a King who is truly just, merciful, fatherly, and loving to the point of death. The ancestor of King David, Jesus, fulfilled every prophecy of the Old Testament and desires for us to spread this Good News until his Kingdom might finally be established here on earth. Jesus declares in our Gospel reading:

"For this I was born and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth.

Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice."

(John 18)
