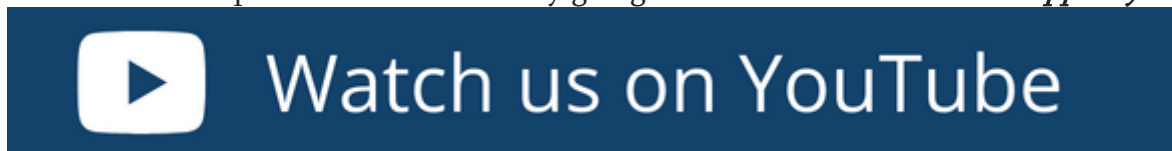

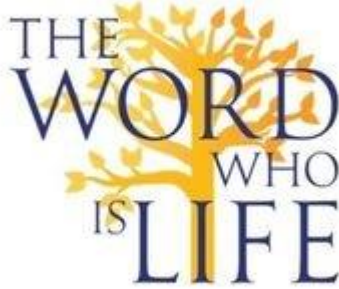

*Sunday, March 23, 2025 / Third Sunday of Lent/ [Luke 13:1-9](#)*

Friends, in today's Gospel, Jesus tells the parable of the fig tree that the owner cursed because it bore no fruit. On a deeper level, we may understand it to mean that the Lord expects us to bear spiritual fruit.

The fruit of the Spirit is the universal, all-embracing consequence of the Spirit's presence in us. All people who live in the Spirit should manifest these qualities. The word "fruit" is especially good in this context.

In Psalm 1 we find this comparison: "They are like trees planted by streams of water, which yield their fruit in its season, and their leaves do not wither." The Spirit is this stream; when we are planted near it, we blossom.

Well, what are these fruits of the Holy Spirit? In the fifth chapter of Galatians, Paul enumerates them:

"love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control."

When discerning whether the Spirit is living in you, in determining whether you are walking the right path, these are wonderful criteria.

If you haven’t yet chosen your “one thing,” there’s still time to get involved! The challenge will run through Lent and continue until the end of April, giving everyone ample opportunity to make a difference. To inspire your efforts and help you rally support, here’s how your contributions could directly impact Year 3 objectives of Project Kimbo, which focuses on improving educational opportunities for the children of Kimbo:

- Fund a nursery schoolteacher for one term - Approx £225
- Fund an experienced primary school teacher (who will enhance educational outcomes and provide vital teacher training) for a term - Approx £225
- Fund a bursary for a child to attend secondary school for a year - Approx £150-200

The need is immense—less than half of Kimbo’s children currently make it to secondary school. Every pound raised will open doors to education, offering these children greater hope for the future. Whether you’re taking on the challenge individually or with family and friends, your efforts will make a tangible impact.
