

SECOND COLLECTION

The Education of Future Priests

This Weekend - The 10:30 am Mass this Sunday will be celebrated on the field so please bring a seat or blanket if attending this Mass. **The 9:00 am Mass will be live streamed.** Some people who do not feel ready yet to return to indoor Masses may wish to avail of the opportunity to visit the church when it is quiet and spend time in Eucharistic adoration. We will continue to live stream at least one Mass each day. The church remains open every day for Mass and private prayer. Please wear a face covering while inside the church.

Jesus is the 'Good Shepherd' and we are his flock or are we?

It's easy to call ourselves Catholics or Christians, but unless we act like it we are only Catholics in name. How can we call Jesus our shepherd or our role model yet not model our behaviour after the most basic of church teachings? How can we be a part of Jesus' flock if we condone violence, ignore poverty or harbour un-Christian attitudes?

Today Jesus tells us how to live our lives. "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me." Hearing Jesus' voice and following him is no easy task.

Jesus asks us to follow him in many individual ways.

Imagine how sad it would be to meet Jesus on Judgment Day, to hear him say, "Didn't you hear me? I was inviting you to travel the world, open a nursing home, research a new drug, become a campaign leader, make a film, write a book, adopt a child, raise funds for a well in a third world country or become a missionary. Weren't you listening?" How would we reply? "Well ... I thought I was listening ... but perhaps I was spending too much time watching TV or following Facebook!" Deciding to follow Jesus might take some radical thinking and a good deal of courage, but for those who make that decision, Jesus promises "... I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish. No one can take them from me."
