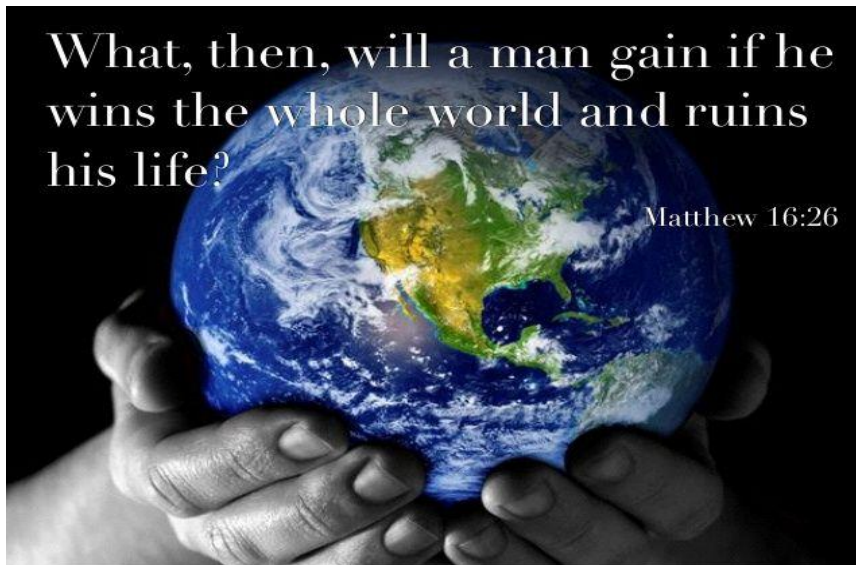

## Face Covering

The Government has announced that face coverings are now mandatory in places of worship, with all those attending church required to wear a face covering or mask unless they are exempt from doing so.

From **Monday 7<sup>th</sup> September** there will be some changes to the times of weekday Mass and Eucharistic Adoration. Full details will be given in next week's newsletter. Thankfully, increased numbers are returning to Sunday Mass so from **Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> September** we will re-introduce the 6:00 pm Vigil Mass. However, to be in line with the diocesan plan of consolidating Masses across the deanery we will only have one Mass on a Saturday (so there will be no Saturday morning Mass). We will re visit Sunday Mass times when restrictions on numbers are lifted.

## **First Holy Communion 2021**

If you have a child in year 3 or above and would like the child to receive their First Holy Communion in 2021 please attend our parents information evening on **Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> October at 7.30pm**. Application forms will be available on the parish website from **Friday 4<sup>th</sup> September**. Please note that one parent will need to complete the CPP Encounter for Parents Course (see below) before the child will be accepted onto the program.

## **CPP Encounter for Parents Course**

Over the last few years we have seen the need to help parents be more prepared for teaching and sharing the faith with their children. The request has come from Pope Francis, the diocese, and some parents. We have designed a very informative three session course for parents to take place at the end of October/start of November. The course is open to all parents of young children, but it will be a *requirement* for parents who hope to enrol their child on the next First Holy Communion Programme. At the end of the course (assuming attendance at all three sessions) parents will be awarded the CPP Encounter Certificate which will allow them to enrol their children on the First Holy Communion Programme. If at least one parent does not have the certificate they will have to wait until

**Donations:** if at anytime you would like to simply donate to our home charity, please send to Mary Lee in the Parish Office. Thank you for your continued support.


