## **Feast of the Epiphany – Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> January**

The feast commemorates the first manifestation of Christ to the Gentiles. We call it the 'Epiphany' a word derived from the Greek meaning 'to appear' or 'to be shown forth'. The Epiphany is about searching for meaning purpose and revelation. The Magi were people of great learning, intellect and wealth, yet they weren't prepared to sit back and imagine they knew it all. Guided by a star and motivated by a hunger for truth, they stepped out of their comfort zone and set out across the desert not knowing what they would find or how long it would take. It was a journey of faith and great courage. The feast could inspire us to look out for ways that God wants us to grow in our spiritual lives, and to use our gifts for God's glory.
