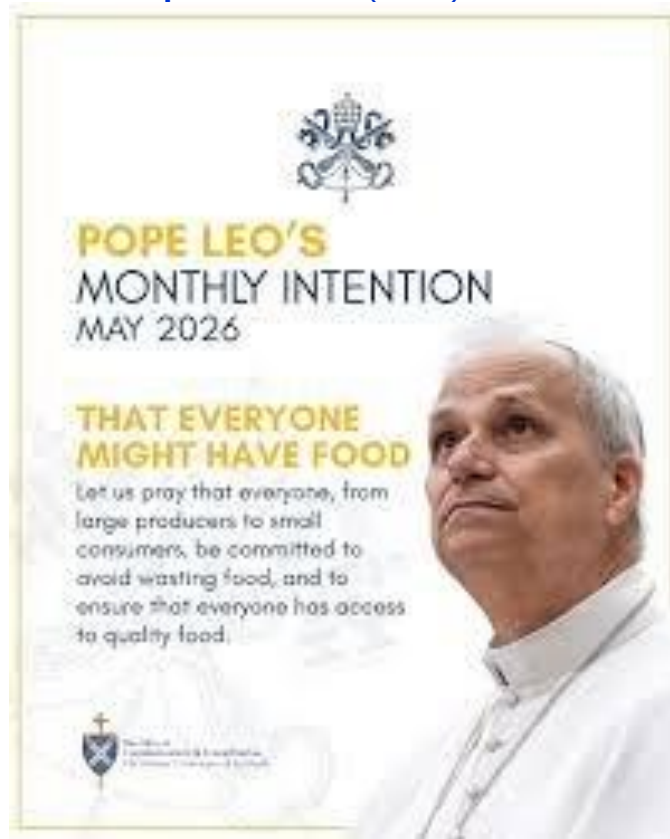

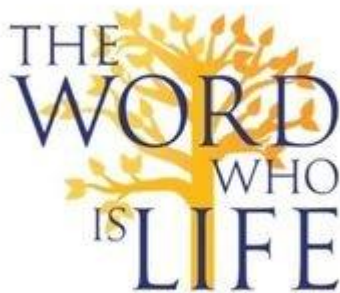

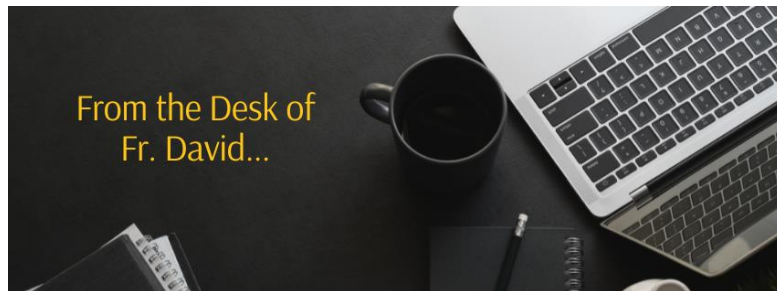

This weekend is one of great joy across our parish family. On Friday evening, forty-seven of our young people from the Christ the Prince of Peace group will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, and on Saturday, others from across our new parish will also be confirmed. We congratulate each one of them warmly and assure them of our prayers.

Confirmation is not a graduation from faith, but a deepening of it. In this sacrament, the Holy Spirit strengthens us with wisdom, courage, understanding, right judgment, knowledge, reverence, and wonder in God's presence. Our prayer is that these gifts will guide our young people throughout their lives and help them become joyful disciples of Jesus Christ.

The Scriptures this Sunday speak beautifully to that calling. In the Acts of the Apostles, the early Church responds to challenge by choosing people full of wisdom and the Spirit to serve others. In Saint Peter's letter, we are reminded that all the baptised are "a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation." And in the Gospel, Jesus says: "Do not let your hearts be troubled... I am the Way, the Truth and the Life." These are words for our newly confirmed, but also for every one of us.

This past week also reminded us that Christian witness matters in the public square. His Majesty the King meeting President Trump in Washington, and the Archbishop of Canterbury meeting the Pope, have been strong examples of this. Pope Leo has spoken clearly for peace and justice, and leaders across the Christian world have echoed the need for reconciliation amid war and division. Faith is never only private; it must shape how we live, speak, and care for others.

So let us continue to pray for our newly confirmed young people.
May they know they belong here, may they use their gifts generously,
and may they help renew the Church with faith, hope,
and love, and may Mary, Queen of the May, protect them with her mantle.

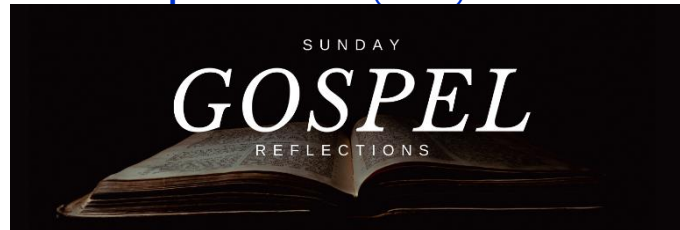

Sunday, May 3, 2026 | Fifth Sunday of Easter | John 14:1–12

Friends, today in the Last Supper discourse, Jesus reveals the mutual indwelling—the coinherence—of the Father and the Son.

John Dunne told us that “no man is an island.” Rather, we are all interconnected.

How do we identify ourselves? Almost exclusively through the naming of relationships.

Coinherence is indeed the name of the game, at all levels of reality.

And Jesus lays out for us the coinherence that obtains within the very existence of God.

“Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me?” Though Father and Son are really distinct, they are utterly implicated in each other by a mutual act of love.

Now, the impossibly good news is that Jesus and the Father have invited us to participate in the life that they share, to enter fully into their coinherence. “In my Father’s house there are many dwelling places.” What is the “house” of the Father but his own life? Jesus’s point is that there is infinite room within the expanse of God’s life. The love between the Father and the Son—which is called “the Holy Spirit”—can be penetrated, entered into, participated in.

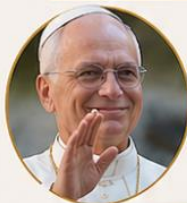

The diocesan Vocations Team has launched a special month of prayer for vocations beginning on **Good Shepherd Sunday, April 26th.**



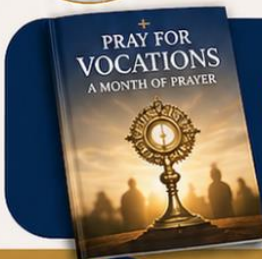
