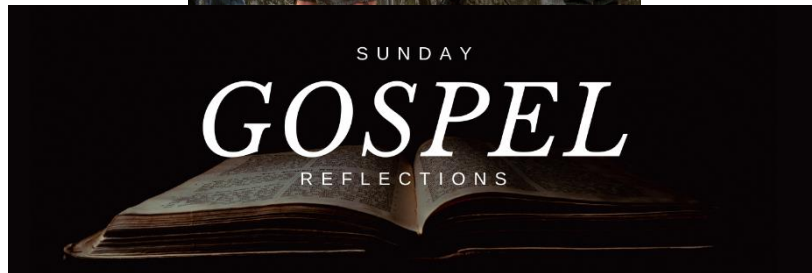

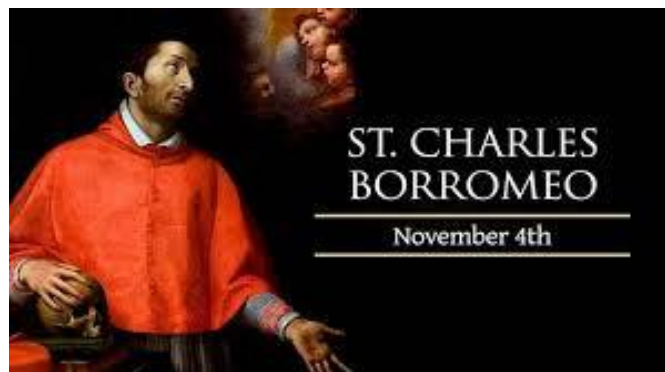

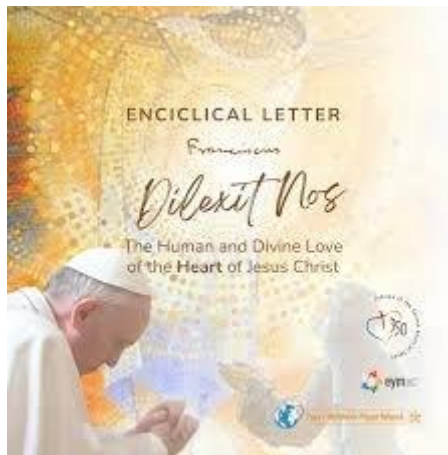
## Prayer to St. Charles Borromeo

The Holy See has again firmly denounced the systematic violation of International Humanitarian Law amid ongoing conflicts around the world, including in the Middle East and Ukraine, reiterating that indiscriminately striking civilians is morally “unacceptable”.

The Vatican's Permanent Observer, Archbishop Ettore Balestrero reaffirmed Pope Francis' words, that even amid the devastations of war every person is sacred, highlighting that the observance of International Humanitarian Law is “not only possible but, moreover, compulsory”.
