





Sunday, April 6, 2025 | Fifth Sunday of Lent | John 8:1-11

Friends, our Gospel today tells about the woman that the scribes and Pharisees caught in adultery. Imagine where they were standing when they caught her in the very act. The voyeurism and perversion of these men! Then they come en masse, in the terrible enthusiasm of a mob, and they present the case to Jesus.

Now, what does Jesus do in the face of this violent mob? First, he writes on the ground. The mysterious writing might indicate the listing of the sins of each person in the group. As Jesus said in another Gospel, "first take the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take the speck out of your neighbor's eye."

And then he says, "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her." He forces them to turn their accusing glance inward, where it belongs. Instead of projecting their violence outward on a scapegoat, they should honestly name and confront the dysfunction within themselves.

This story, like all the stories in the Gospels, is a foreshadowing of the great story toward which we are tending. Jesus will be put to death by a mob bent on scapegoating violence.

#### The Bill To Legalise Assisted Suicide

The Terminally Ill Adults (End of Life) Bill has reached a critical stage in its journey through the Commons. It has completed the detailed scrutiny stage (despite the absence of the essential Impact Assessment and Delegated Powers Memorandum – see below). Virtually all amendments to improve safeguards and protect the vulnerable have been rejected. We are now approaching the Report Stage; the final opportunity to 'improve' the Bill. Then the Third Reading: the final chance to defeat it.

We need to both pray that it will be defeated and act as best we can to register our concerns. Please be guided by Bishop Richard's timely and helpful Pastoral Letter. You will find more resources <a href="here">here</a> and a helpful, quick facility for writing to MPs <a href="here">here</a>. Also, there is a petition <a href="here">here</a> calling on the Government to improve hospice funding, the moral approach to alleviating suffering. The petition closes next Friday, 11 April.

The Bill delegates significant regulatory powers to the Government. This requires a Delegated Powers Memorandum to inform Parliamentary decision-making and would normally be published before the Second Reading (last November) but has not yet been published (see <a href="this Hansard Society commentary">this Hansard Society commentary</a>). Also, the <a href="Impact Assessment">Impact Assessment</a> has still not been published. This is not appropriate for a Bill of such significance. The Bill should not proceed until both are published and MPs have had sufficient time to consider them. If you are going to write to your MP it would be good to raise this concern. Thank you. 
# The Chosen "Last Supper" 10-13 April, various locations
