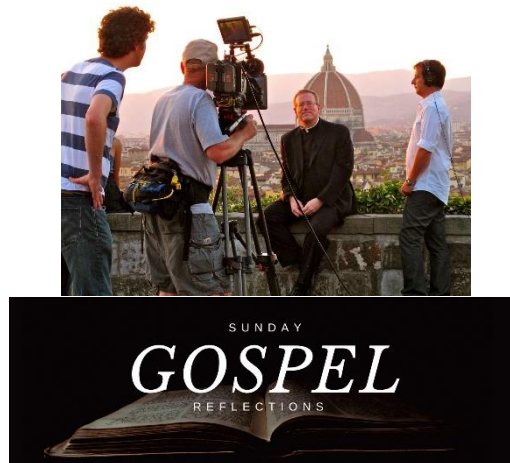

Sunday, June 9, 2024 / Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time / Mark 3:20–35

Friends, in today's Gospel, relatives of Jesus claim that he is mad, and scribes blaspheme him, charging that he is possessed by Beelzebul. You know, in cases like this, the basic problem is always the fearful ego. Ego-addicts know that sometimes the best defense is a good offense. If you want to protect the ego and its prerogatives, you must oppress and demoralise those around you.

There is a very unsubtle version of this method: you attack, put down, insult, and undermine those around you. This is the method of the bully. But the religious version is much subtler and thus more insidious and dangerous. It takes the Law itself—especially the moral law—and uses it to accuse and oppress. “I know what's right and wrong; I know what the Church expects of us; and I know that you are not living up to it.”

Gustavo spent time here in the parish a few years ago when the seminary was closed due to the covid restrictions.

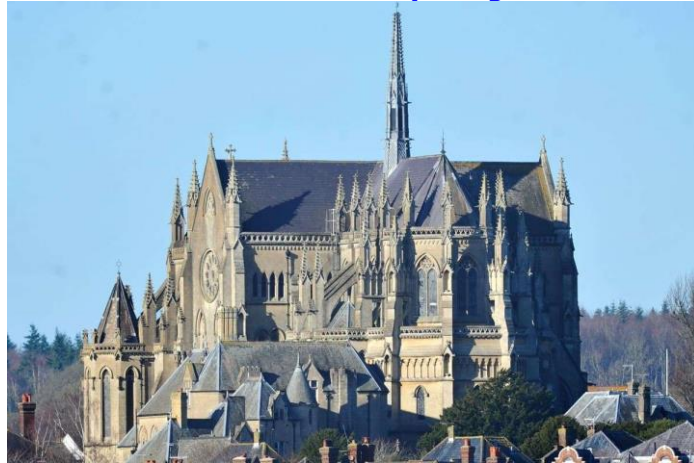

Retirement

Having reached the retirement age for permanent deacons, Deacon Paul's active ministry will conclude on the weekend of 15th and 16th June.

The parish will be marking the occasion with a reception *after the 6:00 pm Mass on Saturday 15th June*.

Everyone is welcome.

The UK Government is seeking people's views on removing the 50% cap on free school faith admissions for new and existing Free Schools and Special Academies, with proposals for opening special faith-based academies. The Catholic Church welcomes the lifting of the 50% cap and is actively encouraging Catholics to take action and support the proposals before the Government's consultation closes on Thursday 20 June.

The Catholic Church is the largest single provider of secondary education in England and the second largest provider of primary education. The current cap has prevented the Church from accessing the funding available to other groups for the establishment of new schools - which means that the Catholic community has been unable to compete on a level playing field. There are two ways that you can support the proposals:
