## Arrangements for Cardinal Cormac's Funeral

Cardinal Cormac's body will be received into Westminster Cathedral at 10am on Tuesday 12 September 2017. The Cardinal's body will lie in Westminster Cathedral throughout Tuesday, and all are welcome to visit to pay their respects, pray, and sign the book of condolence.

At **5pm on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> September 2017** there will be **Vespers of the Dead**, The Cathedral will remain open after Vespers until 8pm to provide a further opportunity for quiet prayer. There will be some unreserved area for those of the faithful who wish to attend.

The **Funeral Mass** for Cardinal Cormac will be at **12 noon on Wednesday 13 September 2017**. Due to the number of people wishing to attend admission is by ticket only. At the end of Mass, the body of Cardinal Cormac will be laid to rest in the nave of the Cathedral, by the Tenth Station of the Cross.

There will be a Memorial Mass in our own Cathedral at Arundel on **Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> October** at 3.00pm.

## Education Sunday

**10<sup>th</sup> September**

The theme of this year's Education Sunday is 'Gathered in my Name', taken from today's Gospel. In this reading Jesus teaches us that wherever two or more are gathered in His name, that He is there among them. This passage has a special resonance for our Catholic schools, as we know that when children gather to learn and to pray, they are gathered in His name. On this day, it is important to give thanks for our teachers, support staff and volunteers, who work hard every day to ensure our schools are inclusive welcoming centres of learning.

Today is also an opportunity to support charities that champion children's education in developing countries. We also remember to challenge child labour in our shopping habits and in our campaigns, in the hope that one day children in developing countries will have the same opportunities as our own children.
