## SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

There are times in the lives of all of us when there is nothing to do but wait. But spending our time waiting is often regarded as a waste of time: we would rather be doing anything than just waiting around. Sometimes we feel guilty when someone say to us "Don't just sit there, do something!". But sometimes the only thing to do is to wait.

One of the reasons we feel frustrated is because we have no control over what happens. We feel passive and powerless.

But there are times when waiting can be a positive experience. When parents wait for the birth of their child, their waiting is full of hope because what they are waiting for has already begun to take place in the womb. So too in the history of God's people, the community wait for the fulfillment of a promise that God will come.

*My soul is waiting for the Lord, I count on his word.  
My soul is longing for the Lord more than watchman for daybreak. Let the watchman count on*

*daybreak and Israel on the Lord (Ps. 129:5-7)*  
As we approach the feast of the Spirit in Pentecost, we are challenged to wait together around the promise of Jesus; to share the conviction of the first community that the Spirit of God will happen here, where we are. We wait in the knowledge that someone wants to reach us, someone wants to visit us with power.

If responsibility is the answer to the spread of fake news, then a weighty responsibility rests on the shoulders of those whose job is to provide information, namely, journalists, the protectors of news."
