



The point is that we live in him and he in us. Jesus is the source of supernatural life in us, and without him we would have none of it. If you are separated from the vine, you will die spiritually; if you are connected to it, you will live a supernatural life.

What does this mean concretely? It means a steady immersion in the prayer of the Church and steady communion with God, speaking to him on a regular basis. It means an immersion in the Scriptures and soaking in the truth of the Bible. It means engaging in the corporal and spiritual works of mercy.


And you must participate in the sacraments—especially Confession and the Eucharist. By the sacraments, we stay close to the Christ who forgives our sins and enlivens our spirits.



The explosive power of Christ (that attracts even atheists!)

After Saint Paul's conversion, he toured the ancient world proclaiming the dunamis of Jesus Christ. That word, *dunamis*, appears 120 times in the New Testament, and it's the root of our English words dynamite and dynamic. It refers to miraculous and supreme power, which Jesus embodies as the Son of God. It's as if Paul were proclaiming "the dynamite of Christ." But what was he getting at? Why does Christ have such explosive power, and how do we tap into it?

The Vatican Dicastery for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments has confirmed its approval for the new Lectionary proposed by the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales last year. The Lectionary, which includes the scripture readings for Mass and the sacraments, is being published by The Catholic Truth Society (CTS) and will come into use in Catholic parishes in England, Wales and Scotland this December. The changes are intended to make biblical translations more faithful to their original languages, using better, more up-to-date biblical scholarship and a text which is more proclaimable.
